# Weyerhaeuser Road Update

- December 1, 2010 Until further notice all Weyerhaeuser roads are open. Please be aware of heavy log haul traffic and increased Oil and Gas Traffic on all Weyerhaeuser Roads. Just a reminder that you should not be using chains on Weyerhaeuser roads without permission where calcium or M spec products have been applied.

## West Fraser Road Use - Headlamps

- Dim Lights to lowest beam when meeting traffic
- Including factory fog lamps and aftermarket lamps
- \$200 Dollar fine per occurrence

## West Fraser Road Use – Passing/Speeding

- A reminder to slow to 50km/h per hour when meeting oncoming traffic
- They will be enforcing this as follows:
  - 1-20km/h over is \$200 fine
  - 21-30km/h over is \$500 fine
  - 31+ km/h over is \$1000 fine plus an automatic “Strike”
  - Strike applies to Master Road Use Agreement Holder (3 strikes allowed)

## West Fraser Road Use – Overweight Vehicles

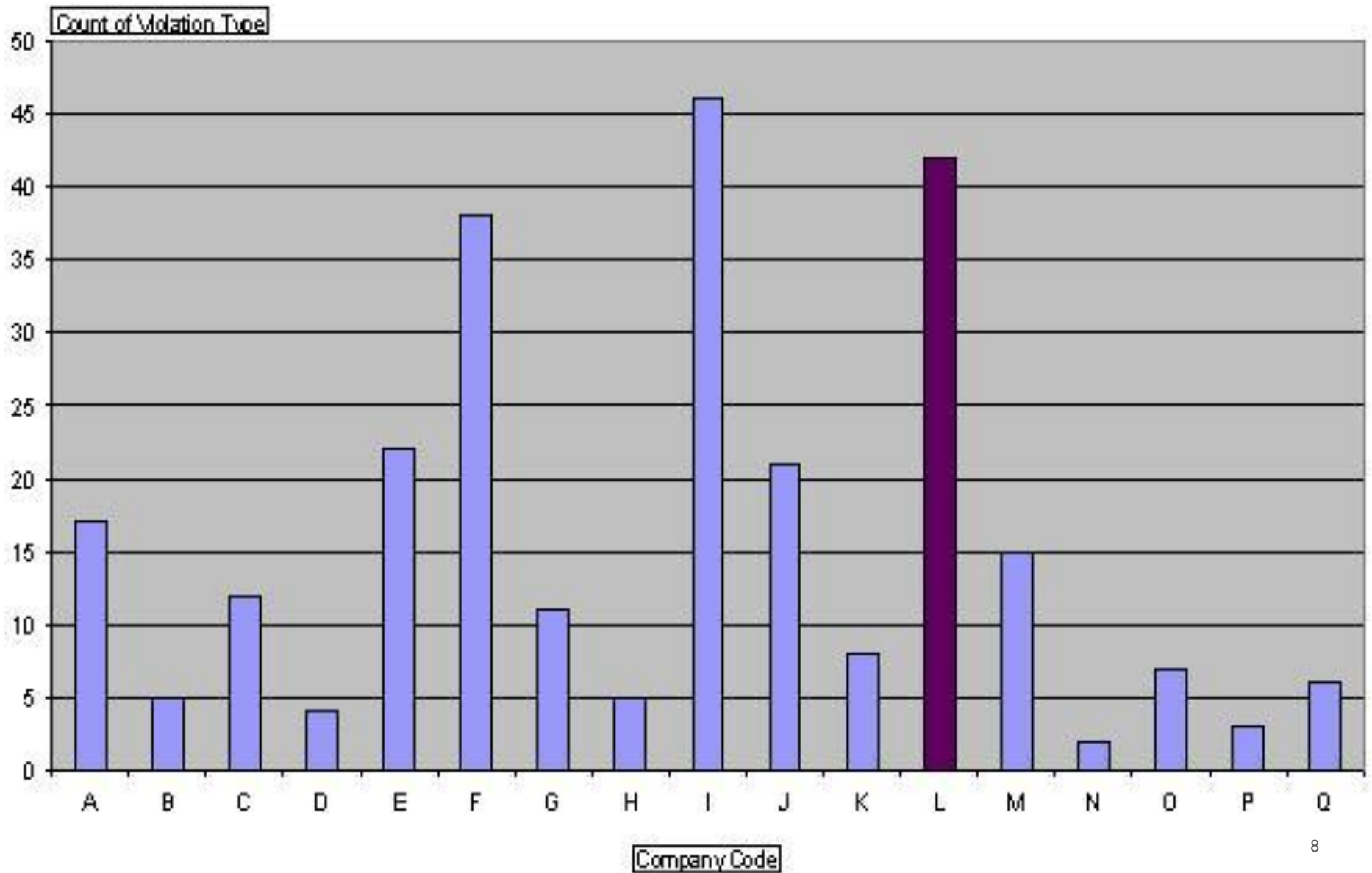
- West Fraser has identified a large amount of grossly overweight trucks
- Specifically contaminated soil and gravel haulers (divisible loads)
- Not targeting non-divisible loads (equipment, components, etc)
- Plan on penalizing grossly overloaded trucks accordingly

## West Fraser Road Use – Radio Protocols

- All vehicles over 11,794 kg must be equipped with a VHF radio for communication purposes and must call **Orange** km markers (**yellow** as required)
- Lighter units should monitor their radios for the heavier units and only respond when necessary.
- Failure to call as required will net the holder of the Master Road Use Agreement a fine of \$200.00
- Use of WFM frequencies is restricted to calling vehicle location and emergency purposes only.

- All business units within Shell have noticed an increase number of vehicle traffic not calling km markers.
- Have had several near misses and a couple vehicles end up in the ditch due to poor communication
- Please reinforce this message home to your drivers
