The following is a short summary of a Life Saving Rule event, investigation, follow up, and learning opportunities.

It is intended to help share information and learn from each event to prevent future occurrences. It is about Saving Lives.

Event Date and Description: 2009-07-10 Driving while using cell phone

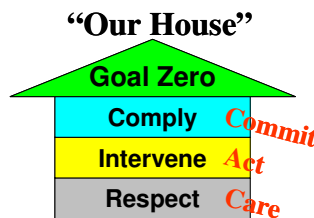
What happened: . A commercial driver was observed talking on a cell phone while driving.
Which Life Saving Rule(s) involved: While driving do not use your phone and do not exceed speed limits
Investigation results: Driver acknowledged he was using the phone while driving Driver was a commercial driver on Shell business
Action taken: Driver acknowledged he knew the rule and was removed from Shell business
Key Learning Points: The rules are clear, if you choose not to follow the rules you choose not to work for Shell

It is about saving lives, and it is working.

Everyone should ensure that we know the rules, follow the rules, and always intervene if there is the potential for unsafe behaviors or conditions. This applies to everyone: peers, supervisors, and visitors.

If in doubt, always consult your supervisor.
